At the end of my bulletin articles, I have been placing the Latin term, *solo gloria dei*, as a tag or conclusion to my article. Since most of us no longer speak Latin, I was recently asked about the phrase and its meaning.


Shout Out: to **Alex Woody** for getting the lead role of Beast in TCCHS's spring production of *Beauty and the Beast*.
